

# BURNIE/PENGUIN AREA

## Impending power upgrade

Aurora Energy is pleased to advise that the reliability and securing of power supplies in the Burnie and Penguin areas will be significantly improved through a \$650,000 upgrade of electrical infrastructure which will result in faster restoration times after interruptions.

### Work commences

Work on this project will commence in mid-April and is expected to be completed by early June 2010.

The work includes:

- General maintenance and upgrading of existing high voltage overhead lines, poles and components.
- New switchgear, automated switches and protection devices.

### Areas affected

The areas affected by this upgrade include Griffith St, Madden St, Bennett St, Thorne St, Crudwell Crt, Colegrave Rd, Sorrell St, Roslyn Ave, Blackwood Pde, Collins St, Pine Ave, Mount St, West St, Deacon St, Queen St, West Park Grove, Seaview Ave, Richardson Cres and the Bass Highway between Burnie and Cooee.

### Disruptions

Due to the scale of the project, there will be a large number of trucks and crews working in the above areas. Traffic control measures will be in place to minimise the disruption to motorists. Motorists are asked to take care during this time.

Although live-line techniques will be used to minimise the impact, outages varying from approximately four to seven hours, will occur in individual areas. All customers affected by a planned interruption will receive an outage notification in their letterbox at least four days in advance of work taking place.
