Course Name: (UET30106) Certificate III in ESI Transmission
(Powerline)

Objective: This course will give the participants a national certification to operate as a qualified lineworker within Tasmania's Transmission environment.

Aurora Energy Training's Transmission Powerline apprentices are involved with the Transmission work crews (Tower Lineworkers) undertaking the daily construction and maintenance of the Transmission network, which is owned by Transend. The tasks undertaken by these crews include:

- Construction and maintenance of transmission towers,
- transmission line patrols,
- replacement of insulators,
- stringing of conductors and
- working alongside electricians within EHV subs.

Please note that transmission linework is conducted in remote areas and at extreme heights.

Prerequisites:

- Year 10 minimum pass mark
- Desired prerequisites include Maths 421 & Science 424.
- Desirable: 18 years and over (for plant licensing purposes)
- A current drivers licence would also be advantageous.
- Optional: Prospective applicants can also undertake pre-vocational training such as Certificate I Electrotechnology.

Duration: Normally 4 years (Dependant on numbers and experience of Trainees)
