Prerequisites:

- Sound physical condition
- Literacy and numeracy skills
- CPR

Delivery by Tasmanian Skills Institute:

- White Card Training – Work Safely in the Construction Industry (CPCCOHS1001A)
- High Risk Licence to operate an Elevated Work Platform (EWP)
- Power system safety rules instructed person
- Electrical awareness

Optional addition

- Traffic Management – Control Traffic with Stop-Slow Bat
 - Additional 1-day
 - Cost \$135/person (minimum 8 people)
 - All regions
