Name a wind turbine Competition

Terms & Conditions

1. These terms and conditions contain information about eligibility for the 'Name a wind turbine Competition ('Competition').
2. The promoter of the Competition is Aurora Energy Pty Ltd (ABN 85 082 464 622) of Level 1, 21 Kirksway Place, Hobart, Tasmania 7000 ('Promoter').
3. Entry is open to all students under the age of 18. Submissions can be submitted as an individual, class or school. Entrants will need the permission of a parent or guardian prior to entering the Competition.
4. Entrants which fulfil any of the following criteria are ineligible to win:
 - (a) The Promoter's employees and their immediate families;
 - (b) Contractors of the Promoter and their immediate families; or
 - (c) Agents of the Promoter (including agencies associated with this Competition) and their immediate families.
5. The Competition will commence on Sunday 1 September 2019 at 08:00 AEST and conclude on Monday 30 September 2019 at 5:00pm EST (the 'Promotion Period').
6. The prize of the Competition is to name a wind turbine at Cattle Hill Wind Farm. There are up to 48 wind turbines to be named.
7. Entrants may enter the Competition by uploading a video of themselves undertaking the 'wind experiment', and explaining how wind turbines create power; providing a proposed name of the wind turbine and reason for the name; and optionally explain why they think wind power is good for Tasmania.
8. Entrants must submit their entry into the Competition via the Promoter's website, with a file size limit of 15mb. Files must be in one of the following formats: wav., mp3 or mp4.
9. All winners of the Competition will be decided based on how creative they are with their experiment. The selection will take place on Monday 14 October 2019.
10. The Promoter reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and reserves the right to disqualify any entrant for tampering with the entry process or submitting an entry that is not in accordance with these terms and conditions. The Promoter may also disqualify entrants whose proposed name for the wind turbine is deemed inappropriate (in the Promoter's sole discretion).
11. The Promoter reserves the right to request the winner to provide proof of identity and residency. Identification considered suitable for verification is at the discretion of the Promoter.
12. The winners' selection will take place at the Promoter's premises at Level 1, 21 Kirksway Place, Hobart, Tasmania. The winners will be notified by telephone and/or email.
13. If for any reason this Competition is not capable of running as planned (including infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoter which corrupt or affect the administration security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this Competition), the Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process, and to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Competition subject to the approval of relevant gaming authorities in Tasmania, where required.
14. The Promoter is not responsible for any problem with or technical malfunction of any computer online systems, servers, relevant service provider(s), computer equipment, software, or any combination thereof, including any injury or damage to entrants resulting from participation or sending or receiving of any communication or of any materials in this Competition.
15. Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, the Promoter (including its respective officers, employees and agents) is not responsible for and excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of: (a) any technical difficulties or equipment malfunction (whether or not under the Promoter's control); (b) any theft, unauthorised access or third party interference; (c) any claim that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected (whether or not after their receipt by the Promoter) due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter; (d) any variation in reward value to that stated in these terms and conditions; (e) any tax liability incurred by a claimant; or (f) use of a gift.
16. The Promoter's decision in relation to any aspects of the competition is final and binding on every person who enters and no correspondence will be entered into.
17. The Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who the Promoter has reason to believe has breached any of these conditions, or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the Competition. The Promoter's legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.

In the case of the intervention of any outside agent or event which naturally changes the result or prevents or hinders its determination, including but not limited to vandalism, natural disasters, acts of God, civil unrest, strikes; the Promoter may in its absolute discretion cancel the event and recommence it from the start on the same conditions subject to applicable State regulations.
